# Earlier Work

Dentaa's media career begun in 2006 as she was first introduced to the viewing public in 2006 with her hit TV show 'The Dentaa Show'. The Dentaa Show which still airs on Fox Life Africa, is an entertainment program filled with exclusive interviews from celebrities in Ghana, Africa, the UK and the United States. The 'Diapsora Transition' edition of the show, is critically acclaimed, amassing a large number of viewers weekly. The Dentaa Show continues to draw in large viewership, and serves as inspiration for many young people aspiring to enter the entertainment industry.

A woman of diverse talent, Dentaa is a dynamic figure within the British/ Ghanaian football industry. She is recognized for managing international football star Asamoah Gyan, and

premier sportsmen/women including: Anton Ferdinand, Rachel Yankey and Christopher Samba, under 'the Speak to Dentaa' agency. She was also instrumental in the Black Stars' securing of the services of Arsenal starlet, Emmanuel Frimpong in 2011.

Additionally, through GUBA, she spearheaded a campaign for the first black footballer – Arthur Wharton to be acknowledged by FIFA in 2012. The success of this campaign led to her invitation by the FIFA President to present a statue of Arthur Wharton at the FIFA headquarters in Switzerland. She was subsequently invited to meet the IAAF President Lamine Diack, to make a ceremonial representation of the Arthur Wharton trophy at the London Olympic Stadium.

Expertly skilled in event planning, coordination and management, she was commissioned in 2012to organize the launch of the Benjani Mwaruwari Foundation in Zimbabwe. As part of this project, she assisted the footballer in building an academy that provides future opportunities for the youth of Zimbabwe.

In 2015, she was called upon to spearhead the celebration of 16 years of reign for His Majesty Otumfuo Osei Tutu II, the King of the Asante Kingdom. This involved the management of various heads of state and dignitaries alike to unite in the acknowledgement of a renowned Royal. Following on, Lady Dentaa was called upon by Clarence house and the government of Ghana, to organize a State Dinner and Fashion show in honour of His Royal Highness Prince Charles (the Prince of Wales) and the Duchess of Cornwall. Influential personnel, Fashion designers from various countries and seasoned professionals were brought to attendance.

In April 2022, Lady Dentaa executed a successful pre-Grammy networking event in honour of Ghanaian musical artiste Rocky Dawuni, who had been nominated for a Grammy award. The event which took place in Las Vegas was a successful precursor to Ghana for the attendees looking to relocate to Ghana.

The Foundation helped raise 8000 cedis equivalent to £1,059.00 to support a young entrepreneur Kelvin Odartei Cruickshank complete his prototype of a car. The 18 year old has been working on the project since he was 15 he's needed support to finish his goal with the help of social media and people who heard his story the Foundation was able to donate the funds to him and his team to enable them to finish the car.





## Nurses Tour- 2019

GUBA Foundation facilitated a ground breaking Nursing Volunteer Program in Ghana November 2019. A group of qualified Nurses from the UK volunteered at Narh-Bita Hospital and Ga West Municipal hospital in Amasaman, they also visited the FOCUS Orthopaedic hospital which specialises in complex spine surgeries over a course of 2 weeks.

This experience was organised to take advantage of Ghana's 'Year of Return', the government-led drive to encourage members of the African diaspora to return to the shores of Ghana in commemoration of the 400th anniversary of the commencement of the transatlantic slave trade. In the spirit of the Year of Return, the GUBA Foundation has increased its focus on work in is a charitable venture giving UK nurses an opportunity to give back to Ghana by sharing their acquired skills and proving medical care to the community. GUBA Foundation are also provided an opportunity for the nurses to experience the beautiful sites and attractions within the country such as the Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Park, Kakum National park and Elmina castle.









# AUTISM CAMPAIGN - 2019

### Autism campaign - #IamNotaStigma

In January 2019, the GUBA Foundation launched the Autism #IamNotaStigma campaign, to raise awareness about autism in the black community and to help reduce the stigma associated with it. The campaign commenced with a forum meeting held at the House of Commons where community leaders and religious worship leaders were invited to hear more about how they can better support families within their communities that are dealing with autism.

The campaign continued with a church tour. Members of the GUBA Foundation team visited 6 churches across London to speak to the congregation about autism and advised the churches on how they can provide an autism friendly environment for their members.





### **GUBA** donates

On Friday 18 January, the GUBA Foundation donated 100 tables and chairs to Tolon Senior High School (Tamale, Ghana). Following an emotive news story about students studying at the school finding it difficult to keep up with their studies due to a lack of basic amenities within the school, such as tables, the GUBA Foundation decided to take action.

We have fundraised over the duration of the campaign (2016-2017) to provide resources to hospitals in Ghana, to help reduce the infant mortality rate. In August 1018 we purchased, donated and installed an essential incubator to the GA West Municipal hospital in Accra, Ghana. Before this donation the hospital had no incubators.

Hospitals in Ghana are under resourced and under equipped. The lack of essential medical supplies contributes to the infant mortality rate. As part of our campaign, the GUBA Foundation supplied 2000 uniforms to several medical clinics in Ghana.



GUBA Foundation, the charitable branch of the GUBA Enterprise, donated more than 2000 pieces of nurses' uniforms on 24th October, 2017, to various health centres in Ningo-Prampram and Ada East districts of the Greater Accra Region. The donation forms part of the Foundation's Infant Mortality Project that seeks to provide deprived hospitals with incubators and other essential medical supplies, to alleviate infant mortality in Ghana.



GUBA Foundation took the awareness campaign to the south of London. This time providing experts in speech therapy, parent training, accessing finance, social work and autism in women. 150 attendees benefited, gaining expert advice and knowledge in how to help their children.

This event was again repeated the following year in the north of London, benefiting over 70 attendees. Children with autism performed. An adult with autism shared his experiences on becoming successfully employed and the importance of early intervention. Members from the community again agreed to be apart of our tv advert helping to reduce stigma. Long lasting and supportive relationships were established through community participation.
